

Summary of Our Charity Care and Uninsured Policies

Thank you for choosing _____ Hospital for your healthcare needs. We are pleased to offer a number of different policies for those who might be unable to pay for their medical care, including those who are uninsured. Please speak to a representative of our billing office (telephone number) or contact our customer service office at (telephone number) for more information. A summary of the policies that we offer is as follows:

Uninsured Patient Discount: _____ Hospital offers a discount off billed charges to all persons who are uninsured. Once we know that you are uninsured, your bill will automatically receive this discount. The discount is __% for all outpatient hospital services and __% for all inpatient hospital services.

Prompt Pay Discount: We also offer a prompt pay discount. If you pay your bill within 30 days of your bill date, we will reduce your bill by an additional 10%.

Charity Care: _____ Hospital offers a generous charity care policy that may be available depending your family's income and assets.

- If your income is **below 200%** of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines, you may qualify for 100% charity care for your hospital bill.
- If your income is between **200% and 400%** of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines, you may qualify for a significant reduction of your hospital bill.

In order to qualify for Charity Care, you will need to fill out an application for financial assistance. Please ask a hospital representative for a copy of the application, which you should return within 30 days of your treatment. In addition, depending on your income, you may be eligible for government assistance with your bill. Our staff will be available to assist you in applying for government assistance.
